***Assist:** The coroner may be called when a person dies in Natrona County, but the origin of the investigation is from another county. Patients may be transferred into a medical facility from other counties, but die in Natrona County. In those cases, the Natrona County Coroner may assist the coroner of jurisdiction, but not conduct the investigation.

****Administrative:** Final disposition or manner and cause of death has yet to be determined by Coroner.

*****Backward Cases:** Coroner cases that were not reported to the coroner at the time of death. By the time notification of death is reported to the coroner, the final disposition may have already been determined and the body either been cremated or buried. An investigation is then completed by the coroner in order verify or rule a cause and manner of death for completion of the death certificate.

Toxicology: Specimens are drawn on all cases for toxicology purposes.

External Examinations: Performed on all cases
