**AMENDMENT ONE TO THE CONTRACT BETWEEN
THE WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES
CHILD SUPPORT PROGRAM
AND
NATRONA COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

1. **Parties.** This Amendment is made and entered into by and between the Wyoming Department of Family Services, Child Support Program, (Agency), whose address is: 2300 Capitol Avenue, 5th Floor, Suite. C, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002 and Natrona County Board of County Commissioners (Natrona County) whose principal office address is 201 North David Street, 5th Floor, Casper, Wyoming 82601.
2. **Purpose of Amendment.** This Amendment shall constitute the first amendment to the Agreement between the Agency and Natrona County. The purpose of this amendment is to; a) increase the Contract amount by two hundred five thousand nine hundred eighty-three dollars and eighty-five cents (\$205,983.85) for the total Contract amount of two million two hundred sixty-eight thousand seven hundred eighty-eight dollars and fifty cents (\$2,268,788.50), and b) correct a clerical error in Section 2 of the original Contract.

The original Contract, dated June 19, 2020, required Natrona County to provide a child support program in full compliance with Title IV-D of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 561 *et seq.* (Title IV-D) and federal law in the Seventh Judicial District for the total Contract amount of two million, sixty-two thousand, eight hundred four dollars and sixty-five cents (\$2,062,804.65) with the expiration date of June 30, 2022.

3. **Term of the Amendment.** This Amendment shall commence on the date the last required signature is affixed hereto, (Effective Date), and shall remain in full force and effect through the term of the Contract, as amended, unless terminated at an earlier date pursuant to the provisions of the Contract, or pursuant to federal or state statute, rule or regulation.
4. **Amendments.**

A. The second sentence of Section 4 (A) of the Original Contract is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Total payment under this Contract shall not exceed two million, two hundred sixty-eight thousand, seven hundred eighty-eight dollars and fifty cents (\$2,268,788.50), including travel based on Natrona County’s operating budget, which is incorporated herein by this reference”.

B. The first sentence of Section 2 of the original Contract is hereby amended to read as follows:

“The purpose of this Contract is to set forth the terms and conditions by which Natrona County shall provide a child support program in full compliance with Title IV-D of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 561 *et seq.* (Title IV-D) and federal law in the Seventh

Judicial District.”

5. **Amended Responsibilities of Natrona County.**

Responsibilities of Natrona County have not changed.

6. **Amended Responsibilities of Agency.**

Responsibilities of the Agency have not changed.

7. **Special Provisions.**

A. **Same Terms and Conditions.** With the exception of items explicitly delineated in this Amendment, all terms and conditions of the Contract and any previous amendments between the Agency and Natrona County, including but not limited to sovereign immunity, shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

B. **Counterparts.** This Amendment may be executed in counterparts. Each counterpart, when executed and delivered, shall be deemed an original and all counterparts together shall constitute one and the same Amendment. Delivery by Natrona County of an originally signed counterpart of this Amendment by facsimile or PDF shall be followed up immediately by delivery of the originally signed counterpart to the Agency.

8. **General Provisions.**

A. **Entirety of Contract.** The original Contract, consisting of twenty-two (22) pages, and this Amendment One consisting of three (3) pages, represent the entire and integrated Contract between the parties and supersede all prior negotiations, representations, and agreements, whether written or oral.

9. **Signatures.** The parties to this Amendment, through their duly authorized representatives have executed this Amendment on the dates set out below, and certify that they have read, understood, and agreed to the terms and conditions of this Amendment.

This Amendment is not binding on either party until approved by A&I Procurement and the Governor of the State of Wyoming or his designee, if required by Wyo. Stat. § 9-2-1016(b)(iv).



SUBJECT: Bid award for a 2020 Compact Track Loader with Attachments to be utilized by the Parks Department on the Mountain.

Bids were received and opened on October 5, 2020 for one Compact Track Loader with attachments. We received two bids, one from Titan Machinery Company 4802 South Garner Lake Road, Gillette, WY 82718 and one from Wyoming Machinery Company P.O. Box 2335 Casper, WY 82602. The low bid was from Titan Machinery Company but did not meet all the required specifications.

Staff recommends awarding the bid to Wyoming Machinery Company in the amount of \$91,360.39. Wyoming Machinery submitted the only bid meeting the specification that were requested. One of the prime bid items was a 5 year/5,000 hour warranty. Titan Machinery Company (Case) bid only 2years on warranty and it did not cover field service. Titan Machinery Company was also out of bid compliance on 18 other items and their service department is located in Gillette, WY so their unit if purchased, would have to be hauled to Gillette for any type of repairs or servicing and all parts would come out of Gillette as well.

Funding for this purchase was approved in the 2020/21 Parks budget line item 9392-013-73 which has 1,000,000 allocated.

It is the intent and purpose of these specifications for Natrona County Government is to purchase, **one (1), 2020 MODEL YEAR TRACK LOADER** furnished as outlined in the attached equipment description.

Prior to delivery, the equipment specified herein shall be completed and serviced as necessary to assure proper operation and function.

NOTE: Any deviations from the written specifications shown in the Request For BIDS shall be noted in the Exceptions Section of the Requisition (see Required Data Section).

In order to receive full consideration, bids must fully follow these Specifications and Request for Bid's General Conditions. The following shall be adhered to for the items bid and will be inspected for completeness at the Natrona County Government's Road and Bridge Shop.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Illustrative and Technical Data: Seller shall submit with bid the complete current illustrative and technical data on the proposed items bid. Failure to render such data may be considered sufficient reason to declare the bid non-responsive.

Replacement Parts: Replacement parts availability shall be a critical consideration in the evaluation of this bid. The bidder shall maintain a stock of replacement parts for each bid item, and shall be in a position to replace such part or parts as may be required for a period consistent with the life of the item(s) bid. 
